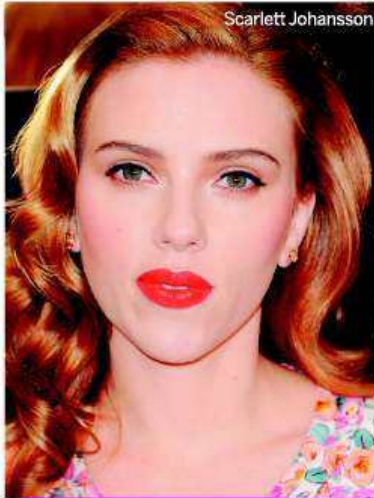

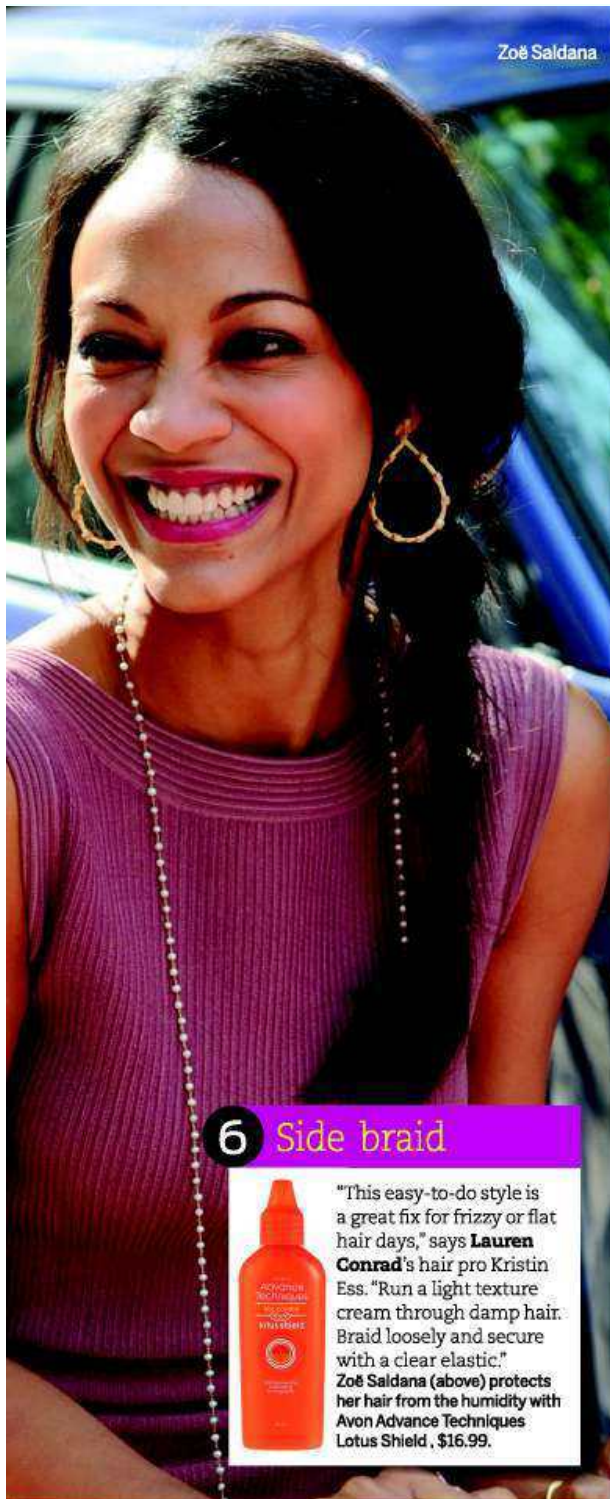
5 Super-blonde hair
