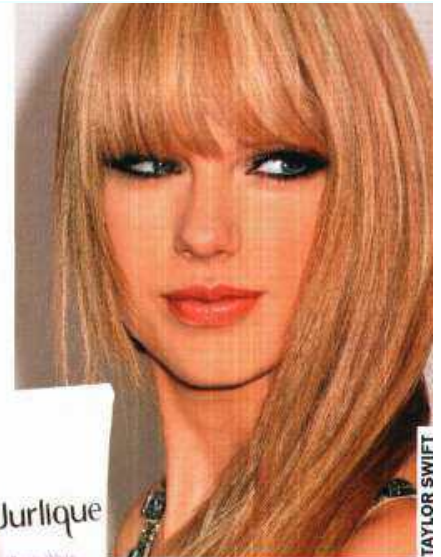

## Under COVER

Choosing the right foundation for your skin type is very important, but the key to creating a perfect canvas is how you apply it. We break down the three ways to ace your base.

**BRUSH:** Best for covering marks and blemishes, a brush can create even, light coverage. Use broad, downward strokes to sweep and blend make-up onto your nose, forehead, cheeks and chin, then use the tapered edges of the brush to

cover hard to reach areas. Be sure to blend thoroughly to avoid leaving brush marks.

**FINGERS:** This method is by far the easiest way to apply foundation. Use your fingers to control application around your nose, eyes and cheeks. But be warned – the oil of your fingers may block pores, so wash your hands



before you apply. If you have an oily complexion, opt for a brush or sponge instead.

**SPONGE:** A sponge gives a thinner finish but provides more control and smoother application than a brush or fingers. Start blending from the outer edges of the cheeks and work towards the nose, then work in circular motions on the forehead and chin. Blend well around your jaw and down your neck to avoid foundation lines.
