The Products: NEW WAVE LASH DEFINERS



Masterpiece Beyond Length Mascara in Burning Amber \$24.95 MAX FACTOR
The spiel: Lengthen and then add colour with this two-in-one rich base coat and pearlescent light-reflecting top coat.
The verdict: No need for falsies! This mascara superbly lengthened and separated my lashes, making it a worthy addition to my beauty routine.

High Lengths Mascara in Black \$38 CLINIQUE
The spiel: Restore limp lashes with this fine-toothed mascara brush designed to draw out the tiniest of lashes.
The verdict: I wear mascara every day, so I've tried many – and this is one of the best! It makes the most of my lashes and really opens my eyes up. I'm a huge fan and I love the curved brush.

SuperShock Intense Mascara in Emerald \$22.99 AVON
The spiel: The microfibres in this metallic-lint coloured mascara plump the lashes up to 12 times their natural size with just one application.
The verdict: Although I was petrified of a coloured mascara, the shade wasn't as intense when I put it on, it just added a hint of colour to my lashes – cute!

Pulse! Perfection Vibrating Mascara in Very Black \$23.95 MAYBELLINE NY
The spiel: This mascara wand vibrates side-to-side, mimicking the wiggle application technique that top make-up artists use.
The verdict: It left a thicker and more defined coat of mascara on my lashes. The vibration takes some getting used to – it's best suited to someone with a steady hand.

Turbo Lash Wand \$35 MODELCO
The spiel: This eyelash curler heats up to 60 degrees and shapes lashes from the root – no matter how short they are.
The verdict: Hello, eyes! This very simple little gadget is easy to use – just heat it up then hold the wand onto your lashes for 20-30 seconds for lashes that pop!

The Treatment: CLIP-IN HAIR EXTENSIONS

WHAT: Headlines Hair Pieces clip-ins are for girls who want the fullness and versatility of hair extensions – without the commitment! The extensions are made from high quality 100 per cent human hair and have a unique snap-lock clip system that holds hair securely in place, without damaging your mane.
WHO: Celebrities such as Hilary Duff and Aussie star Ricki-Lee Coulter are fans of the brand. We sent OK!'s deputy chief sub-editor Jodie to try it out.
OUR EXPERIENCE: 'At the first consultation, my stylist examined my hair and recommended I use three hairpieces for longer and thicker looking hair. She then dyed them identical to my natural colour.'

At my second appointment, my stylist washed and blow-dried my hair and then clipped in the hairpieces. Just minutes later I had long, thick and shiny hair! I was shown how to use the hairpieces, but it's really as simple as just clipping them under my own locks. Layers were cut into the hairpieces around my face so that they blended with my own hair, and then my hair was curled to give it lots of body.
THE VERDICT: 'Wow! My hair was transformed in such a short amount of time! I love that the extensions look natural and are easy to use.'
